

## **LIMERICK ROADWAY ALERTS & CLOSURES**

### **PENNDOT 2019 SUMMER ROADWAY PROJECT UPDATES:**

**Country Club Road** bridge closure from June – August for repair (local traffic permitted up to the SR 422 overpass)

**Airport Road** bridge closure from June – August for repair (daytime flagging to allow access. overnight full closure possible)

Beginning in May, Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission to perform traffic counts throughout the Township. Rubber tubing will be placed across roadway or individual recording traffic from a vehicle parked near intersection

### **PENNDOT ROADWAY RESURFACING PROJECTS (TO BE COMPLETED BY 2021):**

**North Limerick Road** - from Ridge Pike to Twp. Line Road (portions to begin Summer, 2019)

**Neiffer Road** - between Ridge Pike and SR. 73 (portions to begin Summer, 2019)

**SR 422** - between Royersford/Trappe and Sanatoga interchanges

### **LIMERICK TWP PUBLIC WORKS DEPT. 2019 ROADWAY RESURFACING PROJECTS:**

**Aronimink Drive** – from Linfield Trappe to end.

**Country Club Road** – from Linfield Trappe to SR 422 Overpass

**Deerfield Road** – from Mine Run Road to end

**Drake Run** – from Limerick Center Road to Sun Valley Drive

**Evansbrooke Lane** – from Sanatoga Road to Limerick Center Road

**Finley Circle** – from Evansbrooke Lane to end

**Heffner Road** (phase I)

**Lewis Road Maintenance Building parking lot and driveway**

**Metka Road** – from Ziegler Road to Game Farm Road

**Reifsnyder Road** – from Country Club Road to Royersford Road

**Royersford Road** – from Buckwalter to 10th Ave.

**Rupert Road** – from High Street to Limerick Township boundary

**Saylor Road** – From N. Limerick Road to end

**South Limerick Road** (phase II)

**Station Ave.** – from Main Street to Railroad Street

**Sun Valley Drive** – from Ferndale Lane to end

**Swamp Creek Road** – from Neiffer Road to Limerick Township boundary

**Tristen Way** – from Laver Road to end

**Walnel Drive** – from Benner Road to King Road

**Walters Lane** – from Walnel Drive to end

**Note:** All of the projects listed are flexible and subject to change due to budget and/or weather conditions. Dates and times are “tentative schedules”. Please continue to check our website for changes in road projects.

Crews will also be performing line painting throughout the spring and summer. Please avoid driving on fresh paint. Crews will be performing right-of-way mowing and sight distance trimming as well.

All of these projects will require the department to perform prep work. Base repairs will take place as well as some crack sealing in house. All of the drainage updates will be done by Township forces ahead of the improvements. The department will also do the construction of Trinley road culvert which was washed out during the rains of 2018. With these projects and our regular routine maintenance, the department will have a full work load for the season.

Annual street sweeping is scheduled to begin April 8<sup>th</sup> and should wrap up by April 17<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting. Please do not park on the streets from April 8<sup>th</sup> through April 17<sup>th</sup> during the times of 7am to 3pm if possible. Crews will not return to sweep areas where cars had been parked.
