Limerick Township Carnival Inspection Guidelines

1. Ensure proper mitigation of any/all tripping hazards.
2. All applicable health department certifications must be present during the time of inspection.
3. Onsite generator must be properly grounded.
4. All applicable certifications are needed to be current and onsite during the time of inspection for the generator being used as the main source of power.
5. All ride certifications must be current and onsite during the time of inspection.
6. All fire extinguishers with metal tops must be inspected by a third party annually.
7. During the time of inspection there will be a visual inspection of the rides in operation.
8. If applicable, any trailer equipped with a fire suppression system must have current annual inspection and cleaning records for any hood systems.
9. Abate any electrical hazards that may be found during the time of inspection.
10. Ensure proper securing of any compressed gas cylinders.
11. Ensure proper and safe storage of any combustible liquids.
12. Ensure proper securing and stabilization of all rides, temporary structure and trailers.
13. Assign designated smoking areas with appropriate signage.

Please take these guidelines into consideration as you prepare for your Fire and Life Safety Inspection by the Limerick Township Fire Department of Emergency Services.
